Playgroup Activities

1-5 years old



Step 1 – Watch, listen & read the lesson

- My First Chinese Words CD Rom lesson 2 & 3
- Fun Chinese Level I Lesson 2 & 3
- My First Chinese Words Audio CD lesson 2 & 3
- My First Chinese Words Books “What is your name?” & “Who is this?”

Step 2 – Prepare your supplies

- crayons or colored pencils
- paper plates
- construction paper
- glue
- scissors
- yarn, wiggle eyes, feathers



Step 3 – Activities

1. Animal Masks
 - a. Cut out holes for the eyes on your paper plate.
 - b. Add construction paper ears, noses, mouths and add yarn whiskers or feathers.
 - c. Glue onto paper plates to make animal masks.
 - d. Use the mask to pretend you are a cat, dog, bird or other animal from book 3.
2. Make a special page in your scrapbook for your pet or favorite toy.
3. Gather your child’s stuffed animals and have them act out “Who is this” and “What is your name” with funny voices.
4. Guess who I am? Take turns making animal sounds and asking “Who is this – Zhe4 shi4 shei2?” and “What is my name – Wo3 jiao4 shen2 me ming2 zi?”
5. Combine the family names and animal names into a game. If you have more than one toy dog, name one of them the Dog Mama or Dog Baba. Go around naming your toy animals.
6. Sing the 2 songs from Fun Chinese Level 1 Lessons 2 & 3 “Little Girl of the Greenhouse” and “Sister Weiwei”
7. Practice writing the radical for moon featured in My First Chinese Exercises as well as the character for fish from the Happy Character stories on Fun Chinese on large graph paper.
